I ran across a great tool for HF radio called "Where and When". Where and When clearly has the famous German Engineering incorporated. Some of you may have modified the Airmail propagation to allow you to do Ham and Marine voice as outlined in the procedure on this page. That works, but I find it painful to identify what the Lat and Lon are for the location I am trying to call. This product's graphical approach to identifying both ends of the desired transmission makes it simple.

There is also a demo version available you can download for free and try it 5 times.

To get the most out of HF communications, propagation tools are important and "Where and When" makes it about as simple as it gets.
